Opengist pastebin

Linked to our main git forge, we also offer a fully git enabled pastebin service for sharing small code snippets or ad-hoc documentation. You can [access it here](#) via your main account. This service utilizes the great [Opengist](#) software.

IRC channel bot webhooks

You can easily link your git repository or organisation via webhooks to any channel on our hybrid chat network (Accessible via IRC, XMPP and Matrix) with our [advanced channel bot](#). This allows getting fine-grained notifications directly to your chat messenger app and easy collaboration with other members.

Bookstack wiki

Even though every repository has a small built in wiki, it is also possible to use this wiki here for more extensive documentation projects. It is based on the great [Bookstack](#) project and accounts are fully integrated with our git forge.

Weblate translation tool

Your repository can also be integrated with our Weblate tool to crowd-source translations. There is a dedicated section on this wiki about how to use it [here](#).

Real-time code collaboration

We are currently investigating the new [Open-Collaboration-Tools](#) framework for easy peer-programming in VSCode based IDEs and hope to host our own back-end for it soon. Alternatively, you should be already able to use [Saros](#) with our XMPP accounts.
